COVID-19 Protocols for Faith Fellowship Academy

(COVID-19 protocols are based on [CDC recommendations released on December 27, 2021](#))

In the event our school has a positive case of COVID-19, we will immediately notify the parents of those individuals that were exposed. The nature and circumstance of the exposure will determine the Academy's response. Each situation is unique and will be addressed accordingly with guidance from the Brevard County Health Department.

Protocol for a COVID-19 positive individual:

A COVID-19 positive individual should isolate and not return to school for 5 days. The day an individual tests positive is considered day 0, the individual can return to school after the 5th day only if they are symptom-free (without fever for 24 hours).

Protocol for individuals that have had direct contact with a COVID-19

positive individual: ("direct contact" is defined as cumulative exposure for at least 15 minutes within 6 feet of the infected individual.)

The exposed individual shall quarantine and not return to school for 5 days. First day of exposure is considered day 0, the individual can return after the 5th day only if they are symptom-free (without fever for 24 hours).

*Please note if the exposed individual does become symptomatic during quarantine, please contact the Academy office to discuss rescheduling return date.
